

Math Problem Solving Steps, K-2 Student Self-Assessment

- I listened carefully to the problem.
- I read the problem to myself.
- I talked about the problem with my teacher or a friend.
- I highlighted or underlined the important information.
- I thought about how to answer the question.
- I did one of these to show my thinking:
 - showed a pattern, looked for a rule
 - made a diagram
 - made a chart or table
 - made a model to show the teacher
 - acted out the problem
- I solved the problem and answered the question.
- I made an "I noticed..." list to show what I learned.
- I checked all my work.
