<b>Novice</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Selects a topic to investigate with assistance.</li> <li>• Uses research process with assistance.</li> <li>• Selects information, often copying phrases.</li> <li>• Follows organizational plan with supervision.</li> </ul>
<b>Apprentice</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chooses a topic and narrows it.</li> <li>• Follows a provided research plan or process.</li> <li>• Selects information based on topic and summarizes or paraphrases.</li> <li>• Organizes time and resources based on models, peer support, group work.</li> </ul>
<b>Practitioner</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Forms and pursues a question.</li> <li>• Develops a way of researching the question or pursuing the point of view.</li> <li>• Selects relevant sources and information.</li> <li>• Organizes time and resources independently</li> </ul>
<b>Expert</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develops thoughtful and original questions.</li> <li>• Pursues research strategies that are well-matched to the question (e.g. observation, interviews, data collection, and reading) and recognizes new questions or issues as they arise.</li> <li>• Selects relevant and powerful information from a range of diverse sources.</li> <li>• Organizes time and resources to allow for verification, reflection and revision.</li> </ul>
