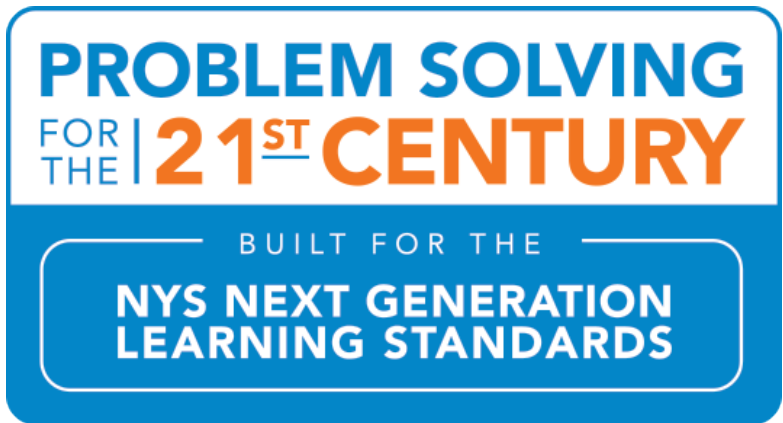

and NY Next Generation Standards**

Exemplars Task Alignments for enVision New York Topics and NY Next Generation Learning Standards

This matrix indicates the NY Next Generation Learning Standards that promote problem solving throughout the enVision New York curriculum. The standards are color coded to match the content emphases established for New York. **Green** defines a major cluster standard, **blue** defines a supporting cluster standard and **yellow** defines an additional cluster standard. A teacher can quickly link a standard that promotes problem solving to an enVision New York Topic and then to the Exemplars Library for task selection(s). Some standards are repeated across Topics which provides students with multiple opportunities to problem solve. Some major cluster standards are located in just one Topic. Teachers might decide to do more than one formative/instructional task in these Topics to provide students the needed opportunity to problem solve within the concept.

Some primary teachers do not include Exemplars problem solving in the first and second Topics. Students' conceptual understanding of a standard will determine when students engage in a problem-solving task. A teacher may decide to replace a lesson in the enVision New York text with an Exemplars task to provide more opportunities for students to show their mathematical thinking. Assessing student work with the Exemplars rubric will support instructional decisions and determine next steps for students.

Teachers may decide to focus mainly on the green-coded (major cluster) standards and do at least two formative tasks per standard. Or, teachers may decide to just do one summative task for each marking period. Conceptual understanding and application of a standard will grow stronger when formative and summative problem-solving opportunities are provided for students as often as possible. The Exemplars Library provides a Preliminary Planning Sheet for each problem-solving task. Assessed student anchor papers with scoring rationales are included for every summative task. The Exemplars Library also includes numerous support materials for teachers and students.
